Apprentices should complete a minimum of 6 hours a week of Off-The-Job Training.

Apprentice Rules

<u>What is "Off-The-Job" Learning?</u>

Learning which is undertaken outside of the dayto-day work duties. This training takes places within the apprentices normal working hours.

You can't go through to Gateway until you have gained enough Off-The-Job Training. **EXAMPLES INCLUDE:**

- CLASSROOM/WORKSHOP LESSONS
- SHADOWING/MENTORING
- WRITING ASSIGNMENTS
- PERFORMANCE REVIEWS AND REVISION
- INTERACTIVE LEARNING
- COACHING SESSIONS/ONLINE LEARNING
